

What is Canvas?



Canvas is an Online Learning Management Software Program. It is available through any web browser or as an app on your smartphone or mobile device. It streamlines classroom work to one location where teachers can post and grade assignments, and students can complete work and receive feedback from teachers. Canvas was adopted by the State of North Carolina in 2014 for all public school districts. UNCC (University of North Carolina at Charlotte), CPCC (Central Piedmont Community College), and NCVPS (North Carolina Virtual Public Schools) have also adopted the use of Canvas.

How do parents access Canvas?

Generating a Student Pairing Code

Parents access Canvas by having their children create a pairing code and using that code during the parent account creation process. creating an account and pairing one or more children during the account creation process. Students create pairing codes by logging into Canvas (through NCEdCloud) and generating a code.

Step 1: Student Generates a Pairing Code

- Student logs into Canvas
- Click *Account*
- Click *Settings*
- Click *Pair with Observer*
- Write down pairing code


How do parents access Canvas?

Step 2: Create a Parent Account & Pair Student

- Go to <https://cms.instructure.com/login/canvas>
- Click *Parent of a Canvas User?*
- Complete the form
- Enter the pairing code from Step 1
- Click *Start Participating*



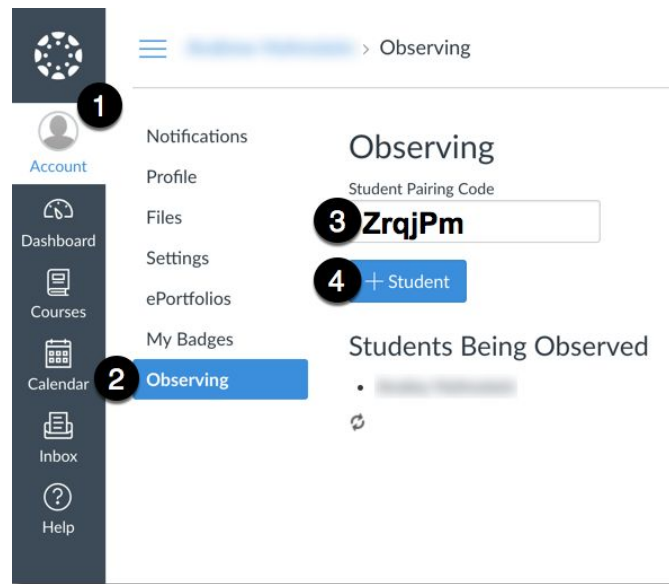

Step 1: Student Generates a Pairing Code:

- a) Student generates a pairing code
- b) Parent logs into Canvas (<https://cms.instructure.com/login/canvas>)
- c) Click *Account*
- d) Click *Observing*
- e) Enter pairing code
- f) Click *+Student*



Canvas Parent App

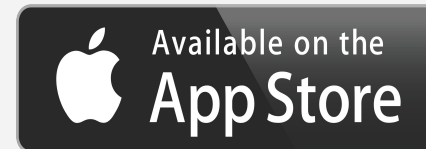


Available for smartphones and mobile devices and found in the Google Play and Apple App Store.

(Android smart phones or tablets)



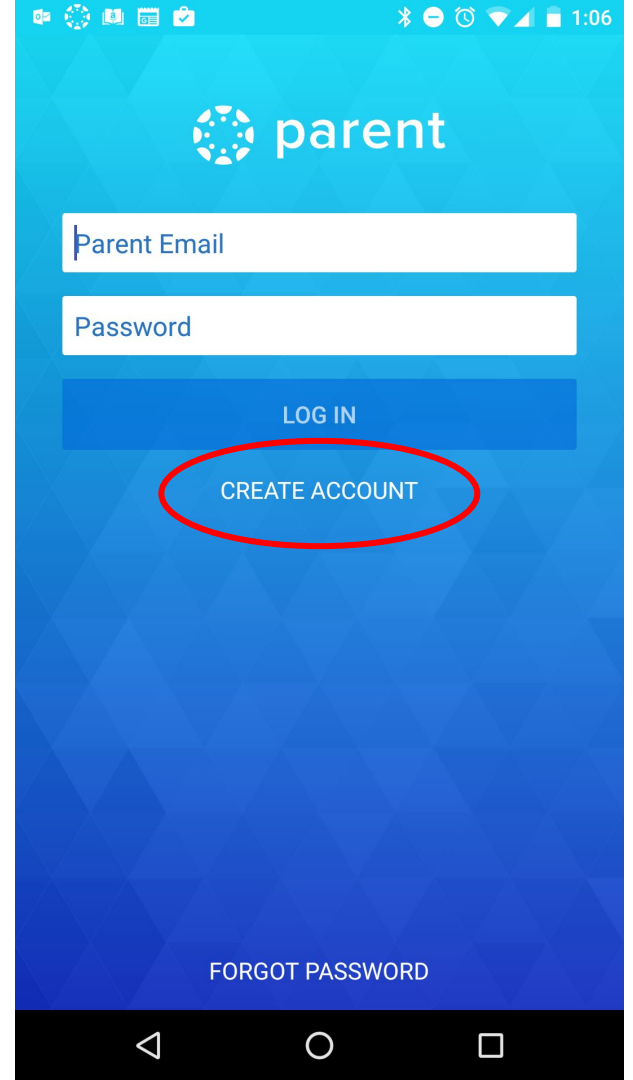
Install the Canvas Parent App on iOS Devices

First Time Accessing The Parent App

Select "CREATE ACCOUNT" the first time you access the app.

Once you have created your account, you can log into the parent app from any device.

Once you have set up your Canvas Parent Account on a computer, then you can set up the app on your phone.

Note under Notifications you can set up how often you would like to be notified of your student work both on the app and on the computer.

Your student's courses

When courses are available, you will be able to see assignment details such as due dates as well as your student's work submitted for that assignment.
